

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP INTENSIFIES WITH TOP TWO SPLIT BY ONLY 6 POINTS

Taking home two wins and a second place, Henry Joslyn took the lead of the Championship at Donington Park. He heads into Anglesey with the confidence of multiple race wins.

Teammate Alfie Davies finished in the top ten for races 1 & 2 but got collected in a lap one incident in race 3. Ethan Carney had a best finish of 16th at Donington Park as he looks to continue his improving streak.

R Racing's newest addition, Chase Fernandez, impressed as he brought home two podiums and a race win in his bid for the Championship title. Teammates Ethan Jeff-Hall and Marcus Saeter secured a rookie class win and overall podium respectively.

After a difficult qualifying session, Harry Moss climbed his way up the grid to get two top ten finishes. Alfie Slater's weekend started well in the top 10, but after an incident in race 3, he'll be looking for a better run at Anglesey.

Still top of the Team Championship by 28 points, Elite Motorsport came away from Donington Park with two overall podium finishes thanks to Charlie Hart and Isaac Phelps.

Archie Clark and Isaac Phelps both secured rookie podium finishes helping to keep the team ahead in the standings. Teammate Ruben Dan rounded off the weekend with a top 10 finish. Max Cuthbert will look to get more points for the team at Anglesey.

Jude Peters had his best weekend for E3Sport with 3 top 10 finishes. He'll be on level with the rest of the grid, making their Anglesey debut.











James Shotton (Fox Motorsport) put on an amazing comeback drive in race 3. Recovering from an incident that left him in last place, Shotton made his way through to 11th, just 0.7 away from a top 10 finish. He looks for more top 10 finishes and a repeat of his class win as he heads to Anglesey.

Jack Robinson secured two Freshman class podiums as he looks for more silverware at Silverstone. Alongside Robinson, Colin Cronin, and Holly Miall return to the grid this weekend.

MDD Racing's Felix Livesey and James Ellis will be returning to the grid for Anglesey. Pace Performance's Torrin Byrne secured three Freshman Class podiums and will be joined once again by Ntiyiso and Mahlori Mabunda who look forward to their second Ginetta race event after Ntiyiso achieved a Freshman class podium at Silverstone.













ROOKIE AND ACADEMY DRIVERS FACE ANGLESEY FOR THE FIRST TIME

Elite Motorsport's Harry Gamble still leads the rookie championship, taking two podium finishes at Donington Park. He'll look to make the most of Anglesey. Teammate Ali Juffali had a good run but looks to improve at Anglesey.

James Nicholas (W2R) came away from Donington Park with two race wins, keeping him second in the championship by just 16 points. He'll be looking to repeat his success and take the top spot.

Luke Shaw rounds off the top 3 after his move to Raceway Motorsport. Shaw secured his first win this season and a podium finish.

Mike Taylor (W2R) had a rough start to the weekend but picked it back up with two top 3 finishes. He'll be looking to regain his championship position. Not far behind, Gareth Thomas will be looking for any opportunity to close the gap to those ahead.

Marc Elman (SVG Motorsport) secured two wins at Donington Park whilst Julian Wantling (E3 Sport) finished on the podium twice. Wantling currently leads the GT Academy championship with Elman not far behind.

Mike West and Lucie Hodgson return to the grid alongside Paul Thomas, Amy and Emma Tomlinson.

Newcomer Jamie Caudle impressed at his first race event, securing three top ten finishes!

PROS AND AMS BATTLE WHEEL TO WHEEL

Mckenzie Douglass (Fox Motorsport) took a clean sweep of wins at Donington Park to take the championship lead with a healthy points margin. With this being his first visit to Anglesey, it may be a challenge for Douglass to keep the top spot!

Xentek Motorsport took class podiums at Donington Park. Both will look to gain more points and take the championship lead at Anglesey.

In the Am class, Nick White (Raceway Motorsport) continues to lead the championship by a fair margin. He secured overall position for race two and finished on the overall podium twice, taking all three AM class wins in the process. Can White go one step further and take an overall win at Anglesey?

Teammate Matt Shaw secured two podiums at Donington Park. He'll be on the hunt for a race win this weekend.

They were joined by Peter Mangion (Am) who secured three class podiums and Harry Mangion (Pro), both returning to Anglesey.

MDD Racing will see Ben McKenna and Gracie Mitchell return as Callum Noble lines up for his second Ginetta event with Xentek Motorsport.

Joining the grid for G Fest, James Taylor takes a step up after his brilliant performance in GTA last year.




